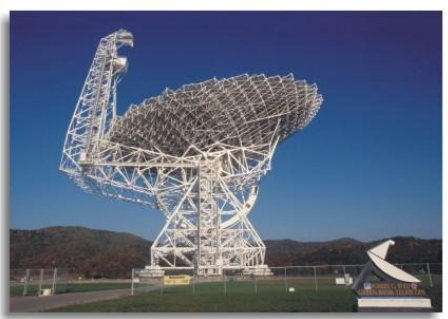




# REGIONAL DRIVE West Virginia Cloverleaf Weekend

**Overview - One Hotel - Three nights - Three drives.**

Using the “cloverleaf” approach this three day driving event will be based out of a central host hotel where we will be staying all nights. We will depart each morning from for a different planned driving tour that contains terrific scenery, historic elements and, of course, fabulous West Virginia back country mountains, “hollers” and twisties.

The driving events will held on Friday, Saturday and Sunday with lunches in route and dinners upon our return to the Lewisburg area. The cloverleaf approach allows participants to join up with the group for as many or as few of the nights and drives as they like. Plan on Thursday arrival for the full event experience. The only requirement is that participants must attend the drivers meeting in the morning at the host hotel. Also, we have blocked a total of 30 rooms for this event, so book early!

Day	Drive	Comments
Thursday, May 19		<b>Arrival, Dinner &amp; Fellowship</b> – For the full event experience plan on arriving on Thursday evening where we gather for ZSCCA fellowship. As we did last year, we will take over the hotel lobby for pizza and light beverages (donations will be taken that night).

<p>Friday, May 20</p>	<p><b>Satellite or Steam</b> – Repeating last year’s event with a slight modification, we drive the sweeping valley’s on Rte 92 up to the Green Bank - Cass areas. Attendees will then have two options: Tour the National Radio Astronomy Observatory (NRAO) in Green Bank, West Virginia or visit the Cass Historic Railroad in Cass, WV (they are 7 miles apart). The NRAO home to the 17 million pound, 2.3 acre radio telescope that charts the universe. This is a research dish farm (think SETI project) that has a visitor center that offers one hour bus tours around the facility. There is a small café on site for lunch. The other choice is to visit Cass, a restored company town built in 1901, which is home to the Cass Historic Railroad - one of the last steam operated lines running in the US. Cass offers the Company Store Diner for lunch.</p> <p>We will allot about 2 hours for visiting the destination of your choice and then rendezvous on top of Snowshoe Mountain Ski Resort for a group picture. We then have a great drive back to Lewisburg on another sweeping route.</p> <p>This is day offers an isolated and shift intensive day of back road driving. Full fuel tanks and a small cooler of beverages is highly recommended. Premium fuel is difficult to come by at most service stations.
